IN CALIFORNIA, THE COST OF CHILD CARE IS HIGHER THAN THE COST OF COLLEGE TUITION AT A PUBLIC FOUR-YEAR UNIVERSITY.

- Despite the Sate securing an additional 200,000 slots in the next 5 years, there are still an estimated 500,000 families in need of subsidize care.
- Some families have been on a waiting list for subsidize care for as long as 15 years.
